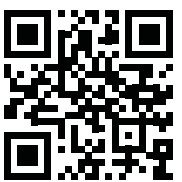

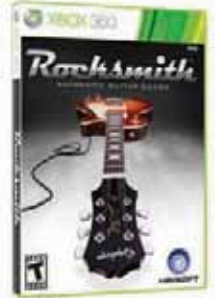

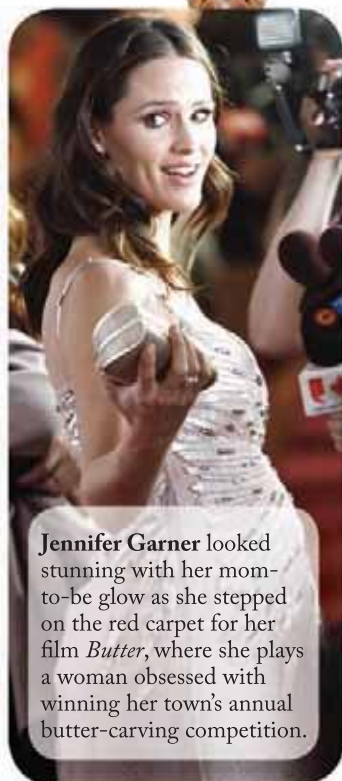


**Ethan Hawke** was one of many stars who signed *Tribute's* snowboard for charity. Hawke came by to talk about his film *The Woman in the Fifth*.

*Charlize Theron shakes things up with a new dark comedy directed by Jason Reitman and written by Diablo Cody.*

She's great at playing real-life characters and has been awarded for her body of dramatic work, but this time around Charlize Theron changes things up by adding a bit of comedy into the dramatic mix.

In *Young Adult*, Theron plays Mavis Gary, a 30-something teen literature author who, after going through a bad divorce, decides to relive her glory days by going back to her hometown of Minnesota to reclaim her

old boyfriend, Buddy Slade (Patrick Wilson). There's just one problem: he's married and is a dad. But for Mavis, who's a pro at throwing back whiskey shots, that's not an issue at all.

"She comes back to break up my marriage because she wants to take me away from my wife," Wilson told Collider.com. "The only problem is that I enjoy my wife, so that's going to be a little tough!"

Not only does her plan to get Buddy back prove difficult, but she also finds that reconnecting with her past doesn't go as smoothly as she would have liked. Mavis then forms an unusual bond with a former classmate (Patton Oswalt) who hasn't quite gotten over high school, either.

Directed by Jason Reitman and written by Diablo Cody, the pair who brought us *Juno*, *Young Adult* is not only gaining buzz with Theron's great performance but it's also being tapped as a possible Oscar contender.

This is the first time we've seen Theron in a movie since *The Road* (2009), but the Oscar-winning actress doesn't plan to go away any time soon. With two more movies on the horizon, including *Prometheus* and the much-anticipated *Snow White and the Huntsman*, Theron plans to return to the big screen in a big way.

# THE GIRL WITH THE DRAGON TATTOO

Daniel Craig and Rooney Mara take on the English version of Swedish author Stieg Larsson's best-selling book.

**A**dapting a best-selling book for the big screen is no easy feat. In fact, directors and actors are up against tough crowds wondering whether or not they'll measure up. This is definitely the case when it comes to Swedish author Stieg Larsson's thrilling *The Girl with the Dragon Tattoo* series.

If you're a fan of the books, you have already got a jump on things movie-wise if you saw the trilogy done in Swedish with subtitles (starring Noomi Rapace); and you also know that each film did not disappoint. Not only are they filled with mystery and intrigue, but they're also notorious for their shockingly violent scenes — especially a rape scene involving its heroine Lisbeth Salander that doesn't hold back, and will have you flinching for days. After all, Larsson didn't call his book *Men Who Hate Women* (the original Swedish title) for nothing.

But could an Americanized version handle the sexual violence played out on the big screen as it did in the Swedish version? Hold on to your

hats, because the word is that director David Fincher (*Fight Club*, *Zodiac*, *The Curious Case of Benjamin Button*) is not holding back. In fact, he plans on making it even fiercer, according to Daniel Craig. "It's as adult as you can possibly make it. This is adult drama," Craig, who stars as Mikael Blomkvist, told *Esquire*. "I grew up, as we all did, watching *The Godfather* and movies that were made for adults. And this is a \$100 million R-rated movie. Nobody makes those anymore. And Fincher, he's not holding back. They've given him free rein. He showed me some scenes recently, and my hand was over my mouth, going, 'Are you f\*\*\*ing serious?'"

In the upcoming remake, Daniel Craig is a natural choice for the role of Mikael, who, after being wrongly convicted in a case involving allegations about a billionaire industrialist and sentenced to three months in prison, sets out to redeem his tarnished reputation by solving the mystery of a missing girl from an influential family. He is joined by professional hacker Lisbeth, who has her own agenda for helping solve the case.

Fans seemed easily accepting of Craig for the part, but many wondered if newcomer Rooney Mara (*The Social Network*) would hold up against Rapace's superb take on the character. "There were discussions early on where people were like, 'She's a superhero!' And you go, 'No, she's not. Superheroes live in a world of good and evil, and she's far more complex than a superhero,'" Fincher told *Empire*

*Magazine*. "She's been compromised. She's been subjugated. She's been marginalized. She's been swept into the gutter and she's had a part in it. She dresses like trash because she's someone who has been betrayed and hurt so badly by forces beyond her control that she's just decided to be refuse. She can sit anywhere she wants on the bus, because nobody wants to deal with her."

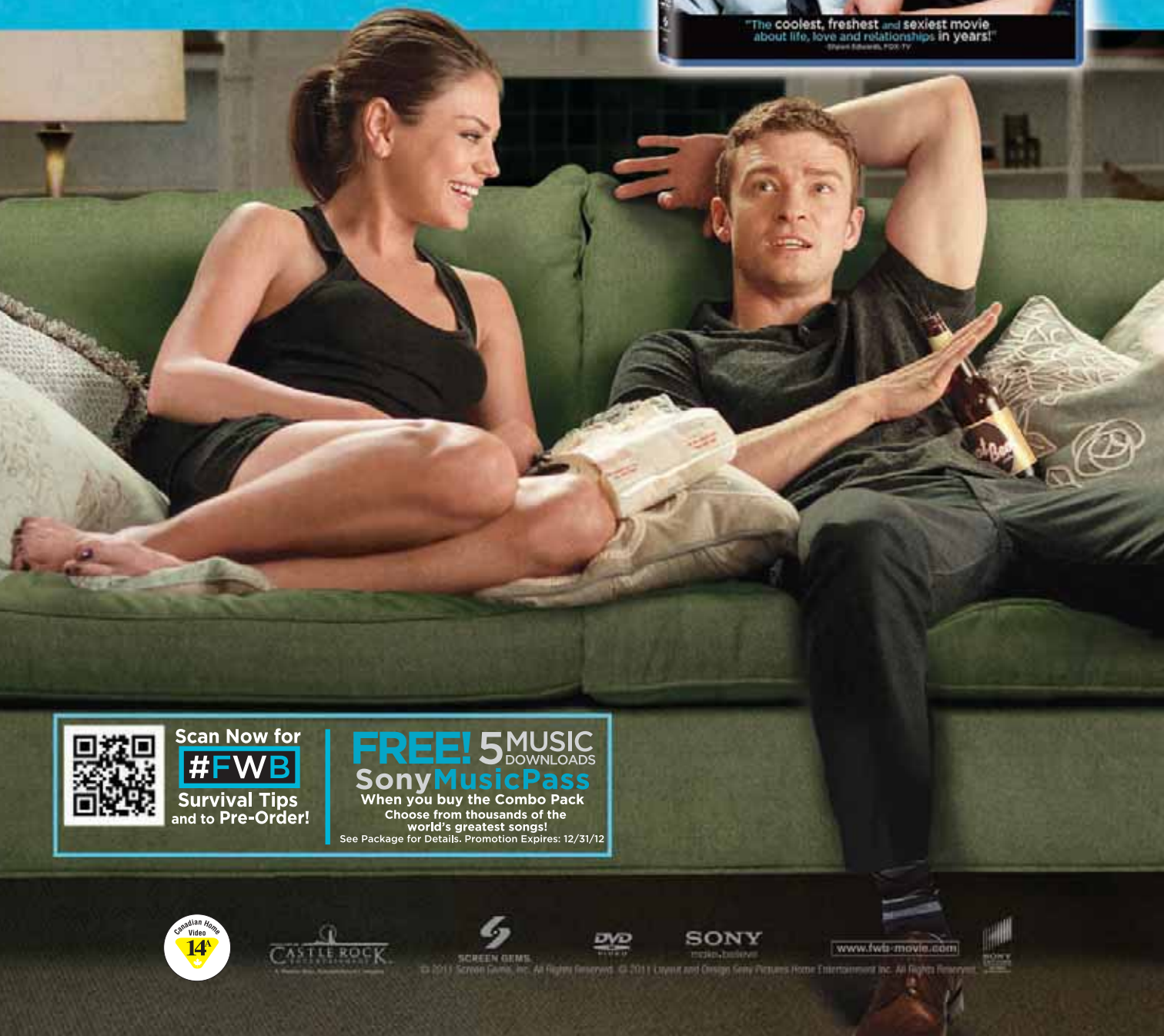
When pictures of Mara's daring transformation into Lisbeth were leaked online, excitement was aroused. However, it wasn't that easy for Mara to convince Fincher. "I was just super-frustrated. I was like, 'You *have* to decide,'" Mara told *Entertainment Weekly* about convincing the director. "Either you think I'm the girl or you don't. There's not much more I can do to prove it to you.' I went in sort of ready to fight. I was pissed. But David sat me down and gave me this long speech about the part. Then he handed me his iPad, and it had the press release on it [announcing she was the one]. He said, 'I'm prepared to send this out. You have half an hour to let me know if you want the part.'"

Knowing what she was up against, and that she was to film a daring rape scene, didn't faze Mara. "It was incredibly intense. We did it all in a week — the week of Valentine's Day, oddly enough. We were working 16 hours a day, and it was really, really challenging, not just emotionally but physically. But it's such an important scene. We wanted to do everything we could to get that right," Mara told *Entertainment Weekly*.

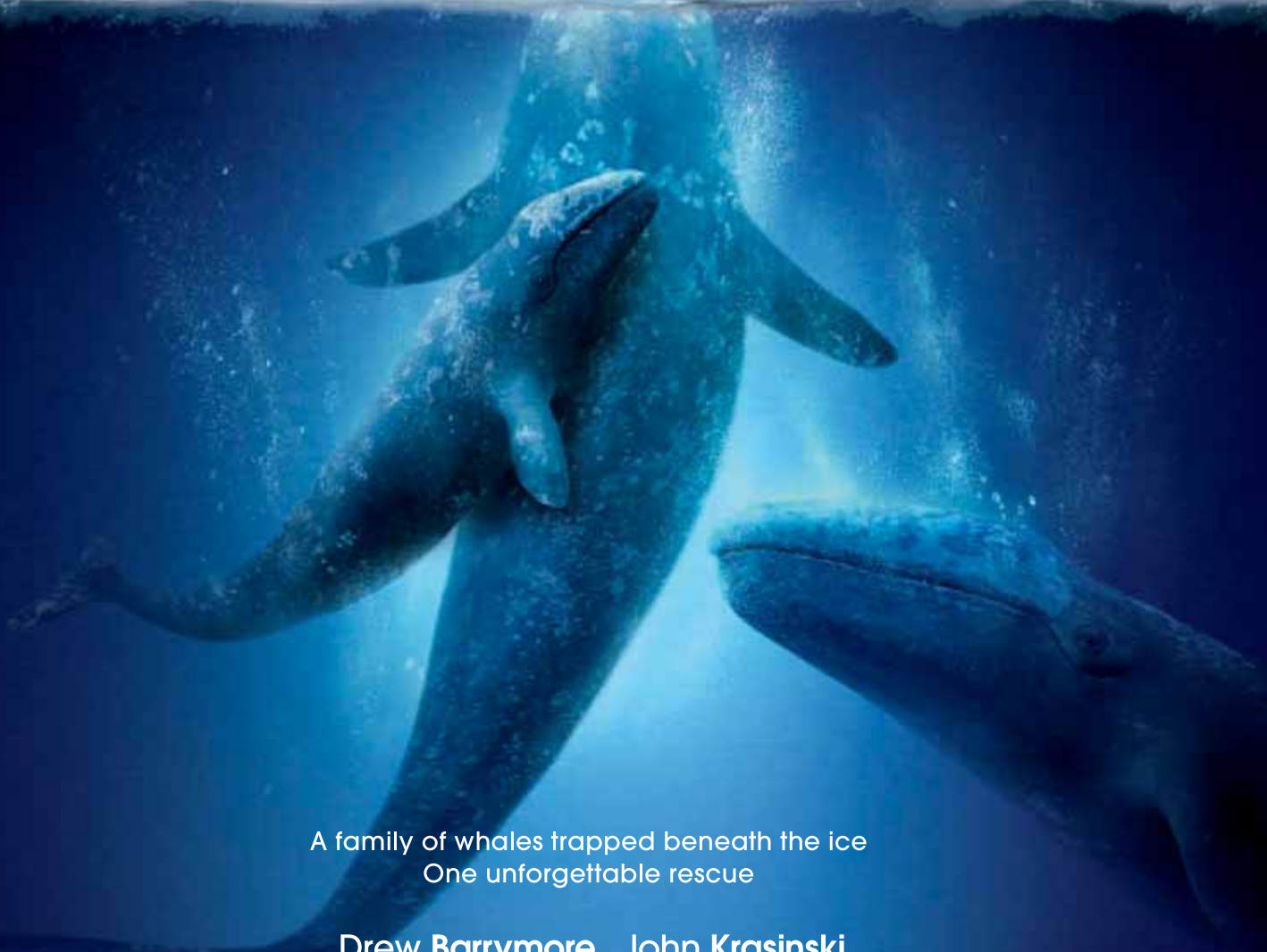

# Love Story

**W**hat happens when a century-old vampire and 17-year-old high school student fall in love? They get married, of course.

Well, they do if they're Edward Cullen (Robert Pattinson) and Bella Swan (Kristen Stewart) – a mysterious young couple from the rainy town of Forks, Washington, and the main characters in *The Twilight: Breaking Dawn Part 1*.

The only difference is, when Edward and Bella pledge to love each other forever, the common “Til death do us part” statement means something a little different than for average folk. Edward can't die, and Bella wants to make sure she won't either, by turning into a vampire and joining him in eternal life.

Unfortunately, not everyone agrees with that idea. Especially Edward. He wants Bella to live her life as a human and experience everything the mortal world has to offer. Her best friend, werewolf Jacob Black (Taylor Lautner), wants to ensure her safety and won't be happy to hear of her impending vows to a vampire – his natural enemy. Worst of all, an old treaty between the Cullens and the Quileutes (Jacob's werewolf family) bans the Cullen family from ever biting a human (the only way to turn Bella into a vamp). Their lives will be at risk if they do.

But when Edward and Bella's honeymoon results in a supernatural

pregnancy and her human body can't sustain what's growing inside her, it may just be the only way to save her life. “I'm incredibly pregnant in the movie,” Stewart told the *L.A. Times*. And what about the prosthetic belly? “I've worn it. It's...crazy. I've done fittings. It gets immense. It gets so massive at some point that it actually looks inhuman. Like it's hurting her. There are striations of bruises.”

But that's the least of their problems. Having a hybrid vamp/human child poses different threats to the wolf pack and vampire coven – who have a rule to never allow children to become vampires. As the Volturi, led by Dakota Fanning, Jamie Campbell Bower and Michael Sheen, come back onto the scene to ensure Edward has made good on his promise to turn Bella into a vampire, a war begins.

*Breaking Dawn* plans to be more emotionally dramatic than the rest of the movies, which is no different off-screen for its stars Stewart and Pattinson. While Pattinson and Stewart aren't open about their off-set relationship, no one can deny their chemistry on-screen. Maybe it's just the magic of the set or the unique connection between their characters, but it's obvious to everyone watching there is something special between them. At no point during filming was this more evident than during the

wedding scene, their co-star Jackson Rathbone (Jasper Hale) said.

“We've been watching this relationship develop and even though we're playing the parts and at the end of the day we wash off that white face makeup and peel back the wigs that we're wearing, when we were there at the wedding scene, all of us felt it,” Rathbone told *E! Online*. “She just walked out; everybody was quiet. Your heart would skip a beat, you get kind of teary-eyed.”

Love. A dream wedding. A baby. It all seems like the typical path to take—but when it comes to Edward and Bella, their lives are anything but average. Luckily, the film isn't either. “It's a very exciting movie,” Lautner told *The Press Association*. “It's very emotional and dramatic, but at the same time, it's a big one. It's very up there.”

# MISSION: IMPOSSIBLE – GHOST PROTOCOL

*Tom Cruise is back on the big screen as the famous Impossible Mission Force operative Ethan Hunt*

**W**ith all the action-packed and nail-biting scenes that make up all of the *Mission Impossible* movies, it's hard to think of how to top one of the movie industry's most-loved franchises. So how can Tom Cruise, who once again reprises the role of hero Ethan Hunt, raise the bar with this fourth installment? "He's insane in the best possible way," director Brad Bird told *Tribute* about Cruise doing his own stunts. "I'd like to think that anyone doing this job is a bit insane, because you're telling stories in a very complicated medium to people of all ages." Adds co-star Jeremy Renner (*The Hurt Locker*): "The stunts have been insane. Tom has been doing loads. He's crazy, that guy. It's unbelievable. He's fearless. He's great to watch," Renner told *MTV.com*. "He inspires me to want to be better. I'm training in the gym and working out and fighting and doing everything I can to try and keep up. I'm doing hand-to-hand combat, Muay Thai and kung fu and learning how to take someone out quickly. I need to look like I know what I'm doing!"

In *Mission: Impossible – Ghost Protocol*, Ethan Hunt and his IMF operative crew are blamed for the terrorist bombing of the Kremlin, and are all disavowed along with the rest of the agency when the President initiates "Ghost Protocol." Left without any resources or backup, Ethan must find a way to clear his agency's name and prevent another attack. To complicate matters further, Ethan is forced to embark on this mission with a team of fellow IMF fugitives whose personal motives he does not fully know.

The film also stars Simon Pegg, Paula Patton, Ving Rhames, Josh Holloway and Tom Wilkinson. But for director Bird, it's Cruise's fearless nature that makes this fourth installment truly spectacular. "He's a star for a reason and he truly loves the medium of film, so he was a delight to work with," Bird told *Tribute*. "It's hard to keep up with him and he just goes and goes like the Energizer bunny. We have more stunts in this movie than in any other *Missions*."
